
Application Guide: Soros Fellowship

A completed application for the Soros Fellowship includes:

- Application form
- Essay on proposed program of study and career goals
- Essay on experiences and accomplishments as a New American
- 3 letters of recommendation
- Transcripts
- Résumé
- Scores of standardized tests already taken (e.g. MCAT, GRE)

Recommended Application Timeline

1. Schedule a consultation with a NS&FP advisor	Mid-Summer 2017
2. Register and begin online application	Early Fall 2017
3. Begin drafting proposed program essay	August 2017
4. Begin drafting New American essay	August 2017
5. Update résumé	August 2017
6. Request letters of recommendation	August 2017
7. Request transcripts	August 2017
8. Request standardized test scores	August 2017
9. Revise proposed program essay	Sep. – Oct. 2017
10. Revise New American essay	Sep. – Oct. 2017
11. Follow up with recommenders	October 2017
12. Application deadline	November 1, 2017

Next steps: Finalists are notified in January, an interviewed between late January and early February. Recipients are announced in late March.
