Free for Emory faculty and students

Access

Can be accessed on separate devices such as smartphones

Features

- Multiple choice, true/false, and short answer format questions and more
- Live Q&A with upvote and downvote
- Can generate Wordcloud based on results
- Images can be added to questions
- Polls can be incorporated into PowerPoint and Google Slides

ZOOM POLLING *videoconferencing application with polling features*

Cost

Free for Emory faculty and students

Access

Polls must be completed on same device used to access Zoom meeting (ie, laptop)

Features

- Multiple choice, true/false, and short answer format questions
- Images can be added to questions

KAHOOT POLLING *game-based platform with polling features*

Cost

Free for students; instructor pays \$5-15 per month depending on class size (\$60-180 per year)

Access

Can be accessed on separate devices such as smartphones

Features

- Multiple choice, true/false, and short answer format questions
- Can generate Wordcloud based on results
- Images can be added to questions

LEARNING CATALYTICS POLLING *interactive student response tool with polling features*

Cost

Free for instructors; students pay \$12 for 6 months or \$20 for one year

Access

Can be accessed on separate devices such as smartphones

Features

- Multiple choice, true/false, matching and ranking, and short answer format questions and more
- Can generate Wordcloud based on results
- Images can be added to questions
- Instructors can select questions from the Pearson Library
- Questions can be saved for future courses
